# CHICAGO VETERINARIAN TO JUDGE AT WESTMINSTER KENNEL CLUB DOG SHOW

Dr. Klein's love of animals started early. He entered his first dog show when he was 11-yearsold. He studied zoology at Miami University and earned his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine from The Ohio State University. For more than 30 years, Dr. Klein has worked as an emergency room veterinarian at Chicago Veterinary Emergency & Specialty Center, Chicago's oldest veterinary emergency facility. As Supervising Veterinarian, he helps oversee the treatment of the more than 11,000 cats and dogs that visit the emergency room each year and a staff of approximately 100 employees.

In addition to judging for the first time at the Westminster Kennel Club show, Dr. Klein has traveled the world judging dog shows. He recently judged a show in Spain and will judge another show in Sweden later this year. He also judges shows throughout the United States.
